Amendment 2 of the FY 2023- 2029 Transportation Improvement Program adds two projects that were delayed from FY 2022. KN 22915 Safe Routes to School is delayed from FY 2022 to FY 2023. KN 21860 Park Lawn to Siphon Road development cost and Right-of-way cost are delayed from FY 2022 to FY 2023. The year and cost of the construction did not change

The Safe Routes to School project is exempt from conformity determination per 40 CFR §93.126. The Yellowstone Park Lawn to Siphon was included in the approved conformity determination and the action does need additional review.

Both actions are meet the criteria for administrative modification as identified in the Transportation Improvement Program.

The Planning Director approved Amendment 2 on October 28, 2022.
