Agenda Item #1 – Approval of TAC minutes from February 28, 2022

Agenda Item #2 – Draft Metropolitan Transportation Plan Goals Revisited

Mori explained that there was no goal related to maintenance or expansion. The staff added Goal 7 to correct the oversight. The TAC reviewed the objectives for all goals and made the following recommendations.

- Add Objective 4.5 to Goal 6.
- Add an Air Quality objective to Goal 5.

Agenda Item #3 – Financial Plan and Project Prioritization

Mori reviewed the basis of the financial plan, which establishes the funding amount for the MTP. Mori reviewed the two main project prioritization options. The goal-based approach had the most support. BTPO will use the application as the prioritization tool for projects funded through statewide competitive projects. The TAC recommended developing scoring criteria for objectives 6.1, 6.2, and 6.3. Scoring criteria for LOS should be added to Goal 7. After the initial project identification, BTPO will request applications from member agencies which will be scored and ranked.

Agenda Item #4 – Draft Metropolitan Transportation Plan Project Lists

The committee reviewed the project list and made changes to several projects. The committee identified several projects in the project table that were not included on the map. The committee agreed to review the list again and provide comments to the staff.
